I - Introduction

On the 29th day of July, two thousand and twenty-one, at 14:00h, the Jury nominated for the call referenced CCMAR/IJ/06/2021, met via Zoom platform, for the award of a position of Junior researcher (M/F) under an uncertain term employment contract within the research project “BIOEXTREMDEGRAD: *Bioaugmentation and conjugative plasmid transference using bacteria from extreme environments to enhance biodegradation of recalcitrant pollutants in WWTP granular sludge*”, ref. PTDC/CTA-AMB/7782/2020 funded by the State Budget, through the Portuguese Foundation for Science and Technology, I.P./MCTES. The jury, included Professor Adelino Canário, Full Professor at the University of Algarve, researcher and President of the CCMAR Board of Directors (President); Professor Maria Clara Semedo da Silva Costa, Assistant Professor at the University of Algarve and researcher at CCMAR (member) and Professor Eduardo Pinho Melo, Associated Professor at the University of Algarve and researcher at CCMAR and met for: decision about the final result following the end of the right of prior hearing of the candidates.
